Happy Father's Day! To all who have sheltered and protected us in emotional, spiritual, or material ways, we say Thank you! May God bless you!! There will be a special blessing for all fathers after the opening prayer.

The big news of the week is that we, at last, have a new "Father," on the Archdiocesan level! The Vatican announced this week the appointment of Archbishop-designate Charles C. Thompson, currently serving in Evansville, IN, who will be officially installed on July 28th. Pope Francis appointed this "shepherd of the flock," the seventh archbishop of Indianapolis. He is 56 years old, a native of Kentucky, has been a priest for 34 years, and has served as Bishop of Evansville since 2011. While he is a small man, he has big shoes to fill and readily admits that, but is eager to begin doing so. Let us join in welcoming him, and pray for his leadership and transition! This speaks highly of the generosity and willingness of this parish to invest in our youth, to passing on our faith to the next generation! Our class sizes are getting smaller, which probably reflects the trend in our society of smaller family size. Many parishes are seeing this decline in numbers. It especially impacts us because of our overall size, and one day soon we may need to combine classes to continue the program. But for now, at least, we are saved by the

number of volunteer catechists.

On Sunday morning last week we received word of the death of Marie Stier. At Mass time we had no arrangements. She was buried from Immaculate Conception on Wednesday of this past week. Please keep her and the family in your prayers. A big Thank you to Eileen Moorman and all of her helpers, the ladies of the parish who so generously donated food and time.
