Please welcome **Father Binoy Akkalayil**, a Trinitarian priest who comes to us from India to do our annual Mission Appeal. The Order of the Most Holy Trinity and of the Captives, was founded in France, in 1198 by Saint John De Matha and Saint Felix of Valois, to free captives and perform works of mercy. Along with the order's mission of ransoming Christian captives, each Trinitarian Community serves the people of its area by performing works of mercy, parish ministries, education, prison ministry, retreat work and youth ministry. For over 810 years (107 years in the US) Trinitarians have chosen to bear witness to God's love in communities where the effects of persecution and poverty are felt most severely. Your support and prayer are vital to furthering their missionary work for the persecuted, poor, marginalized, sick and suffering. Your gifts will enable a quick response in areas of greatest need, as well as support their education projects in India. Thank you for your prayerful consideration.
