**June 11<sup>th</sup>- Feast of Corpus Christi: The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ:**  
Next Sunday is the Feast of Corpus Christi, or the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. After Communion, we will be holding a Eucharistic Procession.

Why? - The Eucharist is the "source and summit of the Christian life" (CCC 1324). After Corpus Christi was established in the 13th century, It became traditional to hold a procession on this solemnity as a public witness of faith in the True Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

"The procession with the Blessed Sacrament...reminds us that we are called to go out and bring Jesus to others. To go out with enthusiasm, bringing Christ to those we meet in our daily lives." - Pope Francis

We will process out of church and begin praying the rosary, reflecting on the life of Christ. At each mystery, we will stop at a station on the map for the reading of a short scripture passage.

Everyone is encouraged to participate. We plan on having quiet golf carts in the back of the procession for those who are unable to make the walk. All servers are invited to assist at the front of the procession.
