**Transfiguration of the Lord:** In the transfiguration, we are invited to see the Lord Jesus as he really is. He is the King of creation. And in the exalted Christ, we see ourselves as we will be when our time comes. This faith awareness should encourage us when we are going through a time of depression and darkness.

In the first reading the author wants to console his fellow faithful who are being persecuted for their faith by King Antiochus. "The Ancient One" is God, and the "Son of Man" is the Messianic King, applied to Jesus Christ.

In the second reading, the author teaches about the exalted Lord Jesus Christ. For those who might refuse to believe in Jesus' second coming, he refers to the transfiguration, as witnessed by the apostles. In other words, the author states that Jesus has already the essential qualities that will be revealed when he comes again. At the end, the writer explains what meditating on the exalted Christ should mean for us, namely a renewed awareness of our own exaltation to come.
