Did you know? - We genuflect (meaning "to bend the knee") on our right knee towards the tabernacle, where Jesus is present in the Blessed Sacrament, as a sign of adoration of the Lord. Unless one is processing in or out, he or she is to Genuflect whenever passing the Tabernacle. It is also customarily done when entering and leaving one's pew at the beginning and end of Mass.
