Reading the word of God-

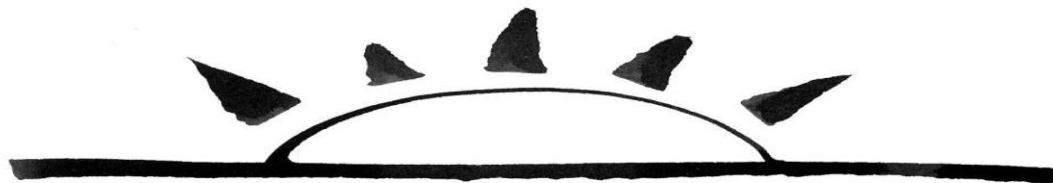
