<u>**Did you know</u></u> - Today is Laetare Sunday. Laetare, which is Latin for "Rejoice", is a title that comes from the first word in the entrance antiphon for today reflecting on Isaiah 66:10-11: "Rejoice, Jerusalem, and all who love her. Be joyful, all who were in mourning; exalt and be satisfied at her consoling breast."</u>**

The Eucharist - Jesus is the Bread of Life, He instituted this sacrament at the Last Supper and said "Truly, truly, I say to you, unless you eat of the Son of man and drink his blood, you have no life in you" (John 6:53-55). The Eucharist, received worthily, nourishes our soul.

In order to receive the Eucharist worthily (1 Corinthians 11:27-29) we must

- a) Be in a state of grace (free of mortal sin)
- b) Fast for one hour
- c) Know whom you are about to receive

We should receive the Eucharist with reverence, then return to our pew and give thanks to the Lord in prayer.

Confession is the means by which to free ourselves of the stain of mortal sin on our soul. In addition to our ordinary confession times, it will be offered this Wednesday beginning at 6 PM. Please, come receive God's grace and forgiveness.
