## <u>Annual collection for Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests:</u>

The weekend of June 8<sup>th</sup> is the annual collection for the Education of Future Archdiocesan Priests. This collection supports our seminarians currently studying for future priestly ministry in the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. Your contributions help cover the expenses involved in the education and formation of these future priests. We anticipate having about 28 seminarians this coming fall, including 8 new men who will be entering formation. We are blessed to have these men in formation in two seminaries right here in the Archdiocese, Bishop Simon Brute College Seminary and Saint Meinrad School of Theology.

The average cost per seminarian for educational expenses is about \$55,000 per year. Funds from the United Catholic Appeal and proceeds from designated endowments support the formation of our seminarians, but those sources do not fulfill the entire need.
