EMERGENCY COLLECTION - GAZA

“The situation in Gaza and across the Middle East cries out for the assistance of the Catholic community of the United States,” said Archbishop Timothy P. Broglio, president of the U. S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB). In a letter to the U.S. bishops, he asked them to consider taking up a voluntary special collection in their dioceses.

We will take up a second collection next Sunday, September 7th, for the people in Gaza and the Middle East. The Mision Office will forward the funds to Catholic Relief Services. Please be generous.
