21st Sunday in Ordinary Time:

After Paul has been trying to describe the bounteous love of God, visible in Jesus Christ sharing himself with sinful humanity, we might say he gives up and exclaims in sudden emotion and gratitude: "Oh the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God!
